"What is 'Evangelism'?"

Does the word evangelism frustrate you? Does it scare you? Do you think that evangelism doesn't work? Today let's dispel some myths.

Evangelism, which shares the same root with *angel* or "messenger," is the sharing of good news (gospel). To put it simply, evangelism is words. We can share Jesus' love in how we live our lives, conduct our business, treat others, etc; but evangelism is specifically sharing the actual words from the Bible.

One common mistake is people think "evangelism = evangelistic series." Yes, a series of meetings with someone speaking to a large crowd can be evangelism, but other things are evangelism, too. Examples include giving someone a Bible or other gospel book like the *Conflict of the Ages* series, teaching a Bible study, explaining to your boss that you need to keep Friday sundown to Saturday sundown holy because Jesus says it is the holy Sabbath day, commenting to the cashier how you are glad Jesus is coming back soon, etc.

As you can see, the definition of the term evangelism is broader than many realize, but it is also not everything we do as followers of Christ. We do many things that are very good but are not evangelism. To illustrate the point, consider that your church is taking flowers to mothers in the community on Mother's Day, and tied to the flower stems are notes with Proverbs 31:25-30 printed on them. The Bible verse is evangelism, but the flower is not. That does not mean giving the flowers without a Bible verse or without saying anything more than a "Happy Mothers' Day!" is bad. It is a very touching gesture and we all should do it if we have the time, but it is not evangelism.

Another example is the health message. Ellen White called it the "right hand of the gospel." Telling people about temperance or taking people's blood pressures is invaluable and can lead to evangelism, but that is not evangelism itself.

Why is it important to distinguish evangelism from other aspects of church activities?

Two reasons, and they are illustrated by two extremes in our church...

First, some members consciously or accidentally only do evangelism and nothing else. All they want to do is talk, but their personal lives do not reflect God's character. That's unhealthy, and artificial. Belief leads to action and change. Evangelism is only effective with evidence of the power of God. You cannot convince someone that Jesus wants them to love Him and love everyone including their enemies if you do not seem to sympathize with others.


Second, some members focus on all the other stuff and forget evangelism. To be fair I think sometimes it is because we equate "evangelism = evangelistic series" when it is much more than that. Still, if all we do is give people a good time and help them with some of their temporal needs but fail to point them to the source of eternal power, point them to their Creator and Redeemer, then we have failed them. If someone gets in a car accident, and the hospital puts some band-aids on their minor cuts and bruises but does not fix the gaping wound in their abdomen or mend their broken arm, has the hospital really helped the patient?

When your pastor says "we need to do evangelism," he is not saying "we need to do an evangelistic series" but instead "we need to do evangelism including series but not excluding lots of other stuff that fits under evangelism." Much of evangelism costs money: buying Bibles, Bible studies material, other evangelistic books, advertising, renting space, etc. You can tell a lot about the spiritual health of a church by how much they budget and spend on evangelism.

As your pastor, my prayer is that you too will "be ready in season and out of season to preach the Word!" (2 Timothy 4:2).

(Adventism's Visitation-Final Chapter)

and drinking His blood. Then we will be prepared to teach the Word of God as we never have done before. We must sink the shaft deeper in the mines of truth. All the little things of life are but a mote now. Those that pertain to eternity are of great consequence." Sermons and Talks, 290–291.

The Temple Cleansing (Ezekiel 9 and 10)

"In the cleansing of the temple, Jesus was announcing His mission as the Messiah, and entering upon His work. That temple, erected for the abode of the divine Presence, was designed to be an object lesson for Israel and for the world. From eternal ages, it was God's purpose that every created being, from the bright and holy seraph to man, should be a temple for the indwelling of the Creator.

Because of sin, humanity ceased to be a temple for God. Darkened and defiled by evil, the heart of man no longer revealed the glory of the Divine One. But by the Incarnation of the Son of God, the purpose of Heaven is fulfilled. God dwells in humanity, and through saving grace the heart of man becomes again His temple. God designed that the temple at Jerusalem should be a continual witness to the high destiny open to every soul. But the Jews had not understood the significance of the building they regarded with so much pride. They did not yield themselves as holy temples for the Divine Spirit. The courts of the temple at Jerusalem, filled with the tumult of unholy traffic, represented all too truly the temple of the heart, defiled by the presence of sensual passion and unholy thoughts.

"In cleansing the temple from the world's buyers and sellers, Jesus announced His mission to cleanse the heart from the defilement of sin,—from the earthly desires, the selfish lusts, the evil habits that corrupt the soul. Malachi 3:1–3 quoted." The Desire of Ages, 161.

"Who are standing in the counsel of God at this time? Is it those who virtually excuse wrongs among the professed people of God and who murmur in their hearts, if not openly, against those who would reprove sin? Is it those who take their stand against them and sympathize with those who commit wrong? No, indeed! Unless they repent, and leave the work of Satan in oppressing those who have the burden of the work and in holding up the hands of sinners in Zion, they will never receive the mark of God's sealing approval. Q&A

At our last district rally, we held a question and answer period. Anyone with any questions relating to the Bible or God or anything along that line, could submit it and the panel would answer it, best that they could. With that in mind, we are starting a similar feature here. Send your question to gracenotesnewsletter.com or through the regular mail and I will forward them, anonymously, to Pastor Justin who will answer them. Try and get them to me as soon as possible so that Pastor has time to research the answer for us. Someone gave me a question to start out with and here it comes. Thank you Pastor Justin for doing this for us and may God bless you in your efforts.

Ouestion:

To God, a day is like a thousand years. During creation, was that a 1000 years per day or?

Answer:

This question references 2 Peter 3:8, which says: "But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day." Some have tried to use this verse to interpret time intervals in the Bible, but Peter is not saying that. The context of verse 8 is that Peter is talking about how God is soon going to bring justice to this world and set things right, but he warns that God's definition of "soon" is not like ours. The next verse, verse 9, Peter continues "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." To say that verse 8 somehow means the days of creation were 1000 years each is abusing what Peter is saying. Let the Bible speak for itself rather than try to manipulate it to say something it is not.

Ouestion:

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved, and your household. What does that mean for our kids that are living a worldly life or even us as children of our parents, assuming they were saved?

Answer:

The question [I believe] is referencing Acts 16:31, which says: "So [Paul and Titus] said [to the jailer], 'Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household." Both questions this month are examples of how context is so important. In this story, because of God's miraculous intervention and Paul and Silas' demonstration of their faith, the person keeping them in the jail wanted to be saved. Important to understanding this, we are told that Paul and Silas were in the jailer's home and his wife and kids were there too, also listening to Paul and Silas' words. We can conclude then that Paul and Silas were not saying that if the jailer believes, then all his household would be saved; but rather that if any one of them believed, then that person would be saved. Praise the Lord we are told in verse 33 that the whole family believed and were baptized!

Gallbladder and Liver Cleanse

Items you need:

4 tablespoons EPSOM salts (food grade (usp) or pharmaceutical grade Not bath grade. (can be purchased at drugstores) 1-2 FRESH GRAPEFRUIT JUICE (not pre-made juice) APPLE JUICE. BOTTLED IS OK

EXTRA VIRGIN OLIVE OIL

It is recommended to do or at least be started on a parasite cleanse before doing the liver flush but not absolutely necessary. Your kidneys and bladder must be working well to flush the body of any released toxins. In the days following a cleanse be sure to drink LOTS of water.

Choose a day that you can sleep in the next morning and not have any major responsibilities till at least noon.

In the morning, do not take any medications that you can do without. Of course, if you need them than take them.

Breakfast:

Have a breakfast with no fats at all. Fruit, oatmeal, plain bread with jam. . . no milk, butter, oil, fats, nut butters etc. Drink plenty of water.

Lunch:

Have a lunch with no fats at all. Spaghetti with oil free sauce, vegetables, etc...

Begin fasting at 2pm. NO MORE FOOD. If you eat after 2pm you may feel very sick later. Have a last large glass of water around 3:30 or 4:00 pm

6pm

Mix: 3/4 c. apple juice with 1 tablespoon of Epsom salts. Dissolve it completely, it takes a moment. Drink it down. You will not get thirsty or hungry after this

8pm:

Mix another 3/4 c. apple juice with 1 tablespoon of Epsom salts, dissolve it and drink it down. Your stomach will grumble and you may even end up on the toilet with soft or liquid stool. This is normal.

Get everything done now that you need to before bed.

9:45pm:

Juice the grapefruit (s), $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ c. is what you need, I find $\frac{3}{4}$ c .best. Put it in a bottle and add $\frac{1}{2}$ c. extra virgin olive oil. Shake it up. Use the bathroom and do all you need to do before bed.

10pm:

STANDING next to your bed, drink the olive oil grapefruit mixture then, right away, lie down on your back with your head and edge of your shoulders up on a pillow. You must stay perfectly still for 20 to 30 minutes. You may feel a strange sensation around your liver area similar to gas bubbles or marbles rolling, this is the stones. You may also begin feeling cold for an hour or so. This is also normal. Go to sleep. I have found it to be quite normal for people to become nauseous or even be sick during the night of their first cleanse. As your gallbladder and liver function improves this will become less and less with each cleanse. If you get the urge to go to the bathroom before the 20-30 min are up, try to bear it out until at least the 20 min though strive for 30. If you do have to run before the time is up it may or may not affect your results.

6am:

Take another dose of the 3/4c apple juice with 1 tablespoon of Epsom salts. You may or may not have gone to the bathroom with diarrhea, expect it. It is necessary to jet the stones out of your system quickly. If you are going to the bathroom before 8am, don't bother with the next dose. If you are not going to the bathroom yet you will need the next dose.

8am:

Take your last dose of the 3/4 c. apple juice with 1 tablespoon of Epsom salts. By 10 or 11 am, you can begin eating lightly.

Weimar NEWSTART Program and the Eight Laws of Health/#6

The Weimar NEWSTART Program uses the acronym NEWSTART to address the eight laws of health; N=Nutrition, E=Exercise, W=Water, S=Sunshine, T=Temperance, A=Air, R=Rest, and T=Trust in God. This article will focus on the benefits of Air. The information is taken from Weimar seminar notes from February 2018.

Benefits of fresh air

Fresh air is chemically different than the recirculated air that most of us breathe. Fresh air produces a healthful circulation of the blood. It refreshes and strengthens the body. Pure air soothes the nerves

A very special bank account

What would you do? Draw out every last dollar, of course!

Well, everyone has such a bank. Its name is Time. Every morning, it credits you with 86,400 seconds. Every night it writes off, as lost, whatever of this you have failed to invest to good purpose. It carries over no balance. It allows no overdraft. Each day it opens a new account for you. Each night it burns the records of the day. If you fail to use the day's deposits, the loss is yours.

There is no going back. There is no drawing against the "tomorrow". Therefore, there is never not enough time or too much time.

Time management is decided by us alone and nobody else. It is never the case of us not having enough time to do things, but the case of whether we want to do it.

and gives the mind composure and serenity. It invigorates the appetite and helps food to digest properly.

Oxygen is best for us when it is negatively charged. Negatively charged air decreases the survival of bacteria and viruses in the air. It also improves function of the lung's protective cilia, lowers the resting heart rate, lowers body temperature and decreases the severity of stomach ulcers.

Negatively charged air has many benefits but some of the most impressive have to do with behavior. It improves a sense of well-being. It decreases anxiety by increasing a sense of relaxation and tranquility.

Indoor air

"Indoor air pollution has been ranked among the top 5 greatest risks to public health by the EPA. Stagnant indoor air allows pollutants to build up and stick to things inside your home." Pollen, bacteria, dust, mold, and other outdoor contaminants can find their way into our homes. There are things in our homes that emit nasty toxic chemicals, like formaldehyde.

Live indoor plants can be good air-purifiers. Some of the best air-purifiers are the garden mum, spider plants, Dracaena, Fichus, peace lilies, Boston ferns, aloe vera, snake plants and bamboo palms. Plants can remove ammonia, benzene, formaldehyde and other toxic pollutants from our

homes. Indoor broad leaf potted plants are a good source of negatively charged air and increase oxygen and decrease carbon monoxide.

We sleep on an average 1/3 of our lives, usually sleeping 8 hours out of a 24 every day. Having fresh air to breathe during those eight hours we are sleeping is important too. Fresh air in the bedroom gives a good night's sleep. Year around, consider opening your bedroom window a crack every night to breathe in fresh air.

Outdoor air

As mentioned earlier, good negatively charged air is the best for us to breathe. Where do we find this good air in the out of doors? Good sources are in natural outdoor environments, like parks with evergreen trees, beaches with surf and after a thunderstorm. Lightening puts an electrical charge in the air producing good negative ions, so walking after a thunderstorm is beneficial. Walking after a rain shower is good too because the rain washes the toxins out of the air.

"We should cooperate with God in the care of our bodies. Love for God is essential for life and health. In order to have perfect health, our hearts must be filled with love and hope and joy in the Lord." *My Life Today*, p. 149 May God bless you as you enjoy God's gift of fresh air!

and the earth was lightened with his glory. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils' (Revelation 18:1, 2). This is the same message that was given by the second angel. Babylon is fallen, 'because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication' (Revelation 14:8). What is that wine?—Her false doctrines. She has given to the world a false sabbath instead of the Sabbath of the fourth commandment, and has repeated the falsehood that Satan first told Eve in Eden—the natural immortality of the soul. Many kindred errors she has spread far and wide,

'teaching for doctrines the commandments of men' (Matthew 15:9).

"When Jesus began His public ministry, He cleansed the Temple from its sacrilegious profanation. Among the last acts of His ministry was the second cleansing of the Temple. So in the last work for the warning of the world, two distinct calls are made to the churches. The second angel's message is, 'Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication' (Revelation 14:8). And in the loud cry of the third angel's message a voice is heard from heaven saying, 'Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities' (Revelation 18:4, 5)."

Selected Messages, book 2, 118.

"Christ had just cleansed the temple of those who defiled it with forbidden traffic. Divinity had flashed through humanity, and men had seen the glory and power of God manifested before them." Review and Herald, April 9, 1889.

Count your stones. The stool will sink and the stones will float because they are cholesterol based. They can be tan, pea green, brown, red, white, black, or anything in-between. Tan and green are most common.

Repeat this cleanse every 2 weeks until no more stones appear. This cleanse can normalize cholesterol levels, rid allergies, stop gallbladder attacks (I had approximately 1250 stones with my first 7 cleanses combined) It takes approximately 2000 stones to really help allergies.

You may feel ill (flu-like, achy) for a couple days following a cleanse, or you may feel energized and amazing. Both are normal and you may experience each with different cleanses.

"Cleansing the liver of gallstones dramatically improves digestion, which is the basis of your whole health. You can expect your allergies to disappear, too, more with each cleanse you do! Incredibly, it also eliminates shoulder, upper arm, and upper back pain You have more energy and an increased sense of well-being.

It is the job of the liver to make bile, 1 to 1.5 quarts in a day! The liver is full of tubes (biliary tubing) that deliver the bile to one large tube (the common bile duct) The gallbladder is attached to the common bile duct and acts as a storage reservoir. Eating fat or protein triggers the gallbladder to squeeze itself empty after about twenty minutes, and the stored bile finishes its trip down the common bile duct to the intestine.

For many persons, including children, the biliary tubing is choked with gallstones. Some develop allergies or hives but some have no symptoms. When the gallbladder is scanned or X-rayed nothing is seen. Typically, they are not in the gallbladder. Not only that, most are too small and not calcified, a prerequisite for visibility on an X-ray. There are over half a dozen varieties of gallstones, most of which have cholesterol crystals in them. They can be black, red, white, green or tan color. The green ones get their color from being coated with bile. Many are shaped like corks with longitudinal grooves below the tops. We can visualize the blocked bile ducts from such shapes. Other stones are composites—made of many smaller ones—showing that they regrouped in the bile ducts some time after the last cleanse.

At the very center of each stone is found a clump of bacteria, according to scientists, suggesting a dead bit of parasite might have started the stone forming.

As the stones grow and become more numerous the backpressure on the liver causes it to make less bile. Imagine the situation if your garden hose had marbles in it Much less water would flow, which in turn would decrease the ability of the hose to squirt out the marbles. With gallstones, much less cholesterol leaves the body, and cholesterol levels rise.

Gallstones, being porous, can pick up all the bacteria, cysts, viruses and parasites that are passing through the liver. In this way "nests" of infection are formed, forever supplying the body with fresh bacteria. No stomach

Think of the liver as a large city with thousands of houses and streets. There are underground pipes for delivering water, oil and gas. Sewage systems and garbage trucks take care of waste products. Power lines deliver energy to the homes and businesses. Factories, transport systems and shops meet the daily supply requirements of its inhabitants. The city is organized in such a way to provide all that is needed for the continued existence of its entire population. To sustain the incredibly diverse activities of all the cells of the body without disruption, the liver must supply them with a constant stream of nutrients and hormones. With its intricate labyrinth of veins, ducts and specialized cells, the liver needs to be free of any obstruction in order to maintain a problem-free production line and frictionless nutrient and hormone distribution system throughout the body.

The liver is the main organ responsible for processing, converting, distributing and maintaining the body's 'fuel' supply. Some actions involve the breakdown of complex chemicals, other important ones involve synthesis, particularly the manufacture of protein molecules. The liver acts as a cleansing station, inactivating hormones and alcohol and drugs.

In all cases, it is the task of the liver to modify these biological active substances so that they lose their potentially harmful effects—a process known as detoxification. Specialized cells in the liver's blood vessels (Kupffer cells) mop up harmful elements and infectious organisms reaching the liver from the gut. The liver excretes the waste materials resulting from these actions via its bile ducts. The leadership of the North American Division values all its members and appreciates the various views they hold on the issues that face our church. We desire to serve all our members and recognize that from time to time there may be differences of opinion, but these should not serve to keep us from our united commitment to the biblical beliefs and global mission of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. We will always follow His call for each of us to become engaged in His mission to reach everyone with the Hope and Wholeness that can only be found in a committed relationship with Him. We are troubled by a recent series of false accusations made in articles published by the layoperated website Fulcrum 7. One such inaccuracy claims that the NAD plans "to ordain 1,000 female pastors." This is a claim that does not represent the intent of the North American Division. The division has stated in the past — and continues to move forward with — its plan to hire 1,000 women for pastoral ministry positions, which is completely in line with General Conference Policy, allowing women to be hired as church pastors.

Fulcrum 7 has also called on Adventist church members to withhold tithe from their local church or conference. Efforts such as these only hinder the evangelistic outreach of the church. The local church is the foundation of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination; reduced tithes hamper mission efforts in the local congregation and community.

Summary

"And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. I am Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last." Blessed are those who do His Commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie. "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches, I am the Root and the offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star." And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. (Revelation 22:12-17).

A perfect example for such a disturbed balance is the increased concentration of the endocrine hormones estrogen and aldosterone in the blood. These hormones, produced both in men and women, are responsible for the correct degree of salt and water retention. When not detoxified, as occurs

Split Pea Soup 1

- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 # green split peas
- 3 quarts water
- 2 bay leaves
- 1 clove garlic
- 4 Tbsp. I use Braggs Aminos
- 3 cups finely chopped potatoes
- 1 cup chopped celery and leaves
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup grated carrots

Soak peas for several hours. Steam onion in a small amount of water. Bring peas to a boil and cook, adding onions and seasonings. Cook until peas are done. Add vegetables and cook slowly until tender, about 20 minutes. Remove bay leaves.
